### Project Description

In January 2007 the Consortium IU-IGIP-SEGU with Infrastruktur & Umwelt as the lead consultant was commissioned with implementing the project "Improvement of Municipal Solid Waste Management, Tangier / Northern Region". The project is financed by GTZ and the project partner is Tangier Municipality. The Project in one of four components of the Environmental Programme Morocco, which is supported by the German development cooperation.

Main focus of the project is the improvement of the waste disposal situation, increased material and energy recovery from waste und reduced CO2 emissions. Other aspects include the monitoring of the private sector performance, training and capacity building.
