WTMK is a unique partnership between the tyre and transportation sector in Kenya, the cement industry, and cooperation agencies and supported by the Kenyan government. A speciality is that different industrial sectors established an alliance to achieve a common objective and that competing companies are committed to cooperate as partners of the Alliance.

The agreement for a strategic alliance has been signed by GIZ and the companies Lafarge, Treadsetters, Multiple Hauliers and Sameer Africa in 2011.

IU has been assigned as technical advisor for the Strategic Alliance.

Results

A sustainable waste tyre management system is established in Kenya.

Thus the following impacts will be achieved:

- Improvement of living and health conditions
- Acceleration of similar initiatives regarding resource efficiency and environmental protection
- Up scaling into other countries of the region
- Reduction of the consumption and dependence on fossil fuel and virgin raw material for the industry
