

# National Strategy and National Investment Plan for Solid Waste Management, Yemen

## Project Description

INFRASTRUKTUR & UMWELT was commissioned by GTZ to implement a project on Solid Waste Management in Yemen, starting in 11/2000. The main focus of the project is to support the Republic of Yemen with regard to the decentralisation of solid waste management to local authorities including training of personnel and the development of policies, regulations and guidelines in the solid waste sector.

Taking into account the experience since the start of the decentralisation process in 2000 a National Strategy for Solid Waste Management in Yemen was developed and approved in 2009. Based on the strategy a National Investment Program for the SWM Sector has been developed.

## Results

- A sector wide approach coordinated by the government for the promotion of Integrated and Sustainable Waste Management in Yemen is realized

- Facilitation of participation and approval process
- Drafting amendment of laws and bylaws for solid waste management
- Establishing the coordination mechanism for the sector-wide approach in the SWM sector

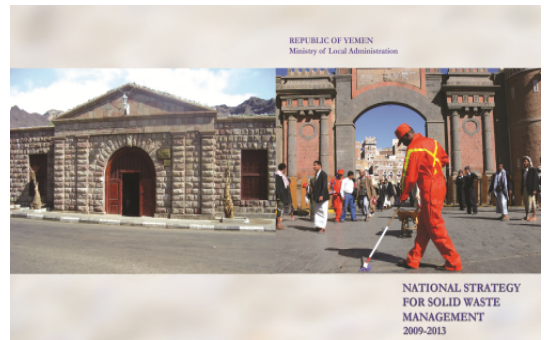
