

## Modernisation of Municipal Services, Kosovo

### Project Description

Municipalities in Kosovo face a huge challenge in providing vital services for their citizens. For example, the country still lacks an organised system of waste management. Waste is simply transported to dumping sites without any sorting or processing, while many rural areas lack waste disposal systems altogether. The population is increasingly dissatisfied with these shortcomings.

The project provides expert, policy and organisational advice at national and local level. Particular emphasis is laid on improving cooperation between national and local government and between government, civil society and the private sector.

IU on behalf of GIZ is providing consulting services for various aspects of solid waste management, such as the development of municipal waste management concepts, cost analysis and detailed planning of pilot measures.

### Results

On the basis of a coherent legal framework that complies with EU standards, municipalities assume their new responsibilities for waste management competently and in a way that is citizen-centred.
