

Accompanying Measures for the Project Solid Waste Management South-East Albania

Project Description

The Korca Regional Waste Management Association (KRWM) is the first of its kind in Albania, serving about 320,000 inhabitants in 28 Local Government Units (LGU). The objective of KRWM is to provide comprehensive solid waste management services to all participating LGUs. For this purpose investment measures, e.g. a new regional sanitary landfill or transfer stations, as well as accompanying measures are necessary.

The Consulting Consortium IU – RWA – FLAG, with IU as Lead Company, will – as Accompanying Measures Consultant – support KRWM as well as the LGUs in developing and implementing sustainable provision of SWM services.

Results

- Local SWM services (mainly collection) are improved
- Logistics for long distance hauling to the new regional sanitary landfill are developed and implemented
- Responsibilities, functions and tasks in SWM service provision are clearly allocated and implemented
- Financial management systems ensure cost recovery and allow continuous monitoring and control
- Waste monitoring and planning systems are established and utilised
- Pilot scheme(s) for on-source separation, re-use and recycling attract interest of public companies and/ or non-profit organisations
- Concepts for maintenance of equipment are developed and applied
- Training and capacity building strengthened KRWM and local bodies in efficient implementation of allocated SWM services
- Public awareness and acceptance has increased and people are willing to participate and to pay fees
