Based on a Feasibility Study carried out in 2014/ 2015 and in accordance with the Albanian SWM legislation and policy framework, it is intended to establish an Integrated Solid Waste Management Programme in the northern municipalities of the Vlora Region (Municipalities of Vlora and Selenica).

The project is funded by KfW Entwicklungsbank and includes the implementation of investment measures for the different stages of waste treatment as well as improving service delivery and financial viability of waste management services.

The German consultancy INFRASTRUKTUR & UMWELT was commissioned for Institutional Consulting Services for supporting Vlora and Selenica Municipalities as well as the NAWSS in the areas of organisational and institutional development, financial management and the implementation of pilot projects.
