

Implementation of the Solid Waste Management Project in the Berat Region, Albania

Project Description

The five municipalities of Berat, Kuçova, Ura Vajgurore, Poliçan and Skrapar of the Berat Region are implementing an Integrated Waste Management Project funded by the Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs SECO and supported by INFRASTRUKTUR & UMWELT, in consortium with SEHLHOFF and FLAG.

The Solid Waste Management Project provides technical assistance, advisory services and capacity development services. It supports the implementation of key national priorities and policies. It is designed to provide for advanced waste management solutions, based on the concepts and standards outlined in the National Waste Management Strategy and Masterplan, in line with EU accession roadmap.

Currently a high amount of waste is ending up in the Osum and Seman River, and subsequently in the Adriatic, because of the poor waste management system.

- Reducing negative environmental impacts
- Addressing immediate short remediation needs
- Laying the basis for future regional infrastructure investments
