

## Solid Waste Management Project South-East Albania Accompanying Measures Phase II

### Project Description

As part of the first phase of the project "Solid Waste Management South-East Albania", the construction of a landfill and other waste management facilities was financed through KfW Entwicklungsbank. In addition to the investment measures, the establishment of a regional waste management company, KRWM was supported.

The aim of the accompanying measures in project phase II is to strengthen KRWM in the proper and sustainable operation of the landfill and the transfer stations and to support the municipalities and the responsible ministry in implementing the new legal and institutional framework in the Korca region.

The overall objectives of the SWM programme are to contribute to the protection of natural resources and the improvement of public health through the mitigation of environmental and greenhouse gas emissions.

Part of budget is reserved for specific institutional and capacity building support to the respective staff of Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy (MoIE) and the National Agency for Water Supply and Sewerage and Waste Infrastructure (AKUM).

### Results

- Strengthening of institutional, organizational and financial management capacities
- Implementation of pilot projects for separation at source, recycling and composting
- Closure measures for the major dumpsites in the region
